### Gauri Sharma Tripathi

Gauri Sharma Tripathi trained in Kathak, under the guidance of her Guru and mother, Padma Sharma. With her company, Amara Nritya Kala Hansa and ANKH Dance UK, she produces events like Dancing under the skies, Kathak Stanzas and Kathak Collective. The repertory of ANKH strives to bridge traditional and new.

## Ashley Lobo

Ashley Lobo has over 35 years of performing, choreographing, and teaching. He is the Founder and Artistic Director of The Danceworx, and Artistic Director of Navdhara India Dance Theatre. Ashley is renowned for his Prana Paint™ technique, a sensitising approach that explores movement through yoga, breath, connectivity and touch.

Spill is a determination to break free from one's psychological imprisonment built through conforming to society's idealistic and narrow perception of existence. Inspired by Sufi philosophy and religious ritual, Sonia Sabri extended the intricate language of Kathak dance creating her unique stamp to express the yearnings of the soul. Celebrating the human body as a visual and aural instrument, she pushes forward the capacity of its physical and emotional expression.
