This year, six artists - Mukti Shri (Kathak), Sooraj Subramaniam (Bharatanatyam), Shreya Kumar (Bharatanatyam), Khavita Kaur (Odissi), Arunima Kumar (Kuchipudi) and Devika Rao (Yakshagana) - will collectively perform five different dance styles in six pieces of work. With their origins spanning four countries, each artist is free to present one traditional and one innovative piece, offering a taster of their extraordinary skill in one spectacular night.
