Shifting Footprints is a foot-stomping, eye-catching multi-media performance, presented by over 120 young people at Stratford Circus.

Akademi's top artists have been working in Newham with Little Ilford School, Gainsborough Primary School, Lister Community School and Eastlea Community School. Shifting Footprints brings together 2 major projects, 'Migrations' and 'Dance Connect', incorporating a mixture of South Asian dance styles, music, DJ-ing, video and poetry.

'Migrations' focuses on issues around refuge and refugees through the collaboration between creative writing and South Asian dance forms (organised and managed by Akademi in partnership with Newham Education Refugee Team and Newham EAZ). 'Dance Connect' integrates a variety of art forms into core curricular activities, encouraging the participants to produce, create and perform their own piece of work.
