#### The Dancer in Me

Based on a poem by legendary dancer Mrinalini Sarabhai, *The Dancer in Me* attempts to juxtapose movement and poetry to celebrate the exuberance of dance itself. Revanta is an independent performer, choreographer, multimedia designer and filmmaker, currently pursuing an MA at Roehampton University. Having made his solo classical dance debut at age 8, he has been performing professionally and touring internationally with the Darpana Performance Group since 1999. Revanta has been showcased at venues and festivals across Asia, Europe, and North America.

### Razor's Edge

Razor's Edge takes the notion of balance in our everyday lives, both physical and psychological, as its starting point and the cost at which that perfect balance is achieved. Combining text and dance, the work is an exploration of the way in which movement speaks and words move us. Anusha trained in Bharatanatyam. She was an artist-in-residence at University of California in 2007 and a Fulbright Scholar to India in 2008. Anusha has performed for Angika, Sadhana and Atma and is finishing a PhD in Critical Dance Studies.

### The Writer

The Writer is a piece of dance theatre that incorporates text, dance and fruit. A coming-of-age romantic relationship explored through the eyes of an inexperienced lover using love letters received during a break-up. The affair is marked by phases of searching, indulgence and anxious regret. Through this process Ankur has overcome his insecurity about creating work that is slightly autobiographical - at least, he thinks he has... Ankur Bahl grew up studying Bharatanatyam and later trained in Contemporary dance at CAFEDANSE, The London Contemporary Dance School and the Ailey School. Ankur has performed for DV8, Shobana Jeyasingh Dance Company, National Dance Company Wales, Rifco Arts and Tara Arts. He has been the recipient of the Fulbright and Marshall Scholarships and The Writer is Ankur's first choreography.

### The Search Within

This fast and energetic piece follows the personal journey of a self motivated individual. A personal tribute to the story of Eklavya from the Mahabharata, *The Search Within* uses movements derived from the ancient South Indian martial-arts form Kalaripayattu and explores being lonely and the source of energy that keeps us going.

### FretLess -

FretLess is dedicated to the memory of Rashpal Singh Bansal, Kamala's friend and a talented choreographer who died in August 2009. Raised in San Francisco, Kamala trained in Bharatanatyam for 12 years under Kalakshetra graduates Katherine and K.P. Kunhiraman and received a degree in Contemporary dance at San Francisco State University. She has performed professionally in Malaysia, India, USA and Mexico. In the UK, Kamala has performed with Shobana Jeyasingh Dance Company, Sankalpam, Sadhana and ENO.
