




TEA DANCE WORKSHOP

London Borough of Camden has set up a new way to offer day opportunities to people living with moderate dementia.



The **Dementia Day Opportunities** are more tailored to individual needs and preferences. People will be able to choose an activity they like from an approved list of providers, who offer small based activities in addition to traditional day centres and clubs.

The service is set up to support those who have been living with dementia for some time and who need extra assistance to meet their needs and outcomes. For example, people who are better supported in smaller groups or who have communication difficulties.

The service is available to all (there are charges). Those who are eligible for care following an assessment by Adult Social Care or Services for Ageing & Mental Health can access the service as part of their support plan.
